Joint Objective

Cory's will combine the existing video conferencing cart with new audio visual technology similar to the Cleveland Country courthouse installation in 2025. There will be some existing technology utilized with a new control and recording system.

Scope of Work

This Scope of Work is in response to a request by Brian Wint at Cleveland County regarding Judge Conyers Courtroom Technologies Upgrade. The following document details the technology and intentions for the installation by Cory's Audio Visual.

All products and services listed in the quote are on State Contract SW1021-C

The following is a full and complete turnkey solution with technology, installation, programming and necessary cabling. Cory's to provide all necessary tools and mechanized equipment for installation.

Basis of the Courtroom System:

The foundation of the courtroom's design begins with its advanced control system. Leveraging the Q-SYS Core OS Platform and a Q-SYS Core processor, the setup enables seamless audio routing and mixing the existing video conferencing cart with the listening system, audio and video conferencing, and audio recording. The integration of beamforming ceiling microphones enhances audio capture with precise, hands-free coverage, while zone-based audio distribution ensures optimal sound across the space.

Audio System:

Cory's will install a new microphone system for amplifying speech throughout the space. Cory's will install four new speakers in the courtroom for audio reinforcement and two new speakers in the foyer area for making announcements from the courtroom. The existing speakers in the bench for the gallery and jury will remain, however a new amplifier will be installed to power the speakers.

- (2) Shure Gooseneck Microphones for Judge's bench and witness stand. These are the highest quality with longer neck microphones to ensure quality audio. These microphones will be amplified through the room speakers.

- (4) lapel style microphones and (1) wireless handheld microphone will be installed for room reinforcement.
- Existing speakers to be utilized in the audio visual system. Cory's will install a new amplifier to power the speakers.
- (1) XLR wall plate at the back of each room for third party, news and media, and another (1) XLR wall plate at the court report location for output to an external recorder.
- (1) Listen Technologies Hearing impaired system installed for ADA compliance.
- (1) Ear loop listening device for Court Reporter

Camera System:

Existing camera system provided on the AV cart will be provided and integrated into the new system.

Control System:

All control system technology is the same for each space allowing for a streamlined approach to ensure if Judges and Court reporters do need to move they know and understand how the system operates. The core allows for the room's audio processing and control from two locations: an iPad located on the Judges Bench and a 10" touchpanel located on the Court Reporters area. An easy to use and understand GUI or graphics user interface, allows for the audio and video sources as well as volume control such as mute and unmute and camera/ recording control. The control system hardware is stored in a new wall mounted equipment rack located in the room. A network switch is provided for the audio video and control system functionality needs.

- (1) QSC Core 24 to control the system's functionality and demands of the audio processing.
- (1) QSC I/O USB Bridge to incorporate the new technology and the existing video conferencing cart.
 - These device allows 1 source: Which will be the mobile cart video.
- (1) 10" QSC Touchpanel for the Court Reporter to control the rooms basic functionality.
- (1) iPad touchpanel in hard shell case with control software to live on Judges Bench to control audio visual system and change sources.
- (1) Netgear Network Switch to allow for inputs and outputs to the system and brains of the control system.
- (1) Small Wall rack for each room to hold power conditioner, QSC technology, and other headend equipment. This allows us to move the equipment from the workspace area to free up foot space in the bench area.

Video System:

Existing video system to be reutilized. Cory's will install an input/output device to strip audio from the

cart to play throughout the audio system in the courtroom.

Training and Commissioning

Training and commissioning are included in this proposal along with delivery and initial setup of the conferencing systems.

Commissioning includes:

Manual test-out of all connections, any and all new equipment, and programming functions to ensure a working system before client system sign-off.

Training that will include up to a four-hour session per space of a Cory's Audio Visual professional, project manager, engineer, or other trained representative running through the system function, operation, and Q&A with designated client representatives/operators at the end of the installation process.

Client Deliverables

The client agrees to provide or facilitate the following:

- Power and data at installation sites. Electrical call-outs to be done prior to installation.
- Patching any holes in the wall from removing old equipment.
- Existing speakers in the gallery and jury box in working order.
- Existing video conferencing cart to be utilized and connect to the new system.

Assumptions

Below is a list of assumptions that were observed during the site visit(s), should the assumptions listed below be inaccurate there will be a change order provided that could result in additional charges.

- Wall structure is drywall with metal studs.
- Ceiling structure is droptile ceiling.
- There are no obstructions in the wall or ceiling preventing the installation of cabling and mounting hardware.
- Adequate wirepath from equipment rack location to installation sites in each space.
- Space for small equipment rack in courtroom to store technologies headend.

Timeline

- This proposal and pricing expires **May 31st 2026** after that date pricing is to be used as a budgetary number and need to be rebid.
- Initial deposit is 50% due upon signing with the remaining 50% due at project completion. Technology is not ordered until deposit is received. Unless otherwise specified.
- After signing this proposal, a site visit will take place with Cory's operations team prior to ordering equipment to ensure no changes need to be made.
- Technology typically arrives in 4-8 weeks unless requesting custom items.
- Estimated completion is one week.

When you ask us to perform repairs or similar services, and where such services are not covered under Additional Terms between us, you agree that your verbal request and direction for those services constitutes an Order under this Agreement, and, in any event, we will document such services in a written work order.

 - i. Subject to Article III below, you agree that you will be invoiced by us as goods are procured or services performed, or as otherwise agreed in the Order between us, including any authorized expenses or related charges. Unless otherwise agreed between us, you are responsible for reasonable and necessary travel and out of pocket expenses related to the performance of services under this Agreement.

In addition to all other remedies available under this Agreement or at law (which we do not waive by the exercise of any rights hereunder), we shall be entitled to suspend the delivery of any Equipment or performance of any services if you fail to pay any amounts when due and have not paid such amounts within ten (10) business days of our notice to you regarding such nonpayment.

- i. Any special-order Equipment that is custom made by either Seller or the manufacturer cannot be returned and payment for those items is due in full upon acceptance of the Order.

14. **Limited Warranty.**

- i. We warrant to you that we will perform services under this Agreement in a professional and workmanlike manner, using skilled and experienced personnel, and in accordance with generally recognized industry standards for similar services. In the event of a claim under this warranty received by us within thirty (30) days of our performance of the applicable services, we will, in our sole discretion, reperform the affected services or refund to you amounts you paid for the affected services at the pro rata rate under the applicable Order. **THE FOREGOING REMEDY IS YOUR SOLE REMEDY AND OUR ENTIRE LIABILITY WITH RESPECT TO A BREACH OF WARRANTY UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH.**

22. **Confidential Information.** All non-public, confidential or proprietary information of ours, including but not limited to, specifications, samples, patterns, designs, plans, drawings, documents, data, business operations, customer lists, pricing, discounts, or rebates, disclosed by us to you, whether disclosed orally or disclosed or accessed in written, electronic or other form or media, and whether or not marked, designated, or otherwise identified as "confidential" in connection with this Agreement is confidential, solely for the use of performing this Agreement and may not be disclosed or copied unless authorized in advance by us in writing.
