

AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO ARPA SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT

This amendment number one (the "Amendment") to the ARPA Subrecipient Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into this 27th day of July, 2026 by and between Cleveland County ("COUNTY") and Community Works, LLC ("SUBRECIPIENT") for project 1.008 Mental Health Pilot Programs.

WHEREAS, the COUNTY and SUBRECIPIENT entered into an agreement on July 15, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the SUBRECIPIENT will have excess funds which will not be spent by the expenditure deadline and desires to have those funds reclassified to support a previously obligated project in Cleveland County; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY and SUBRECIPIENT have agreed to amend this agreement as follows:

- I. Modify **Exhibit A1: Subaward Data** as follows to adjust the amount of the award from \$1,000,000 to \$775,000:

Amount of Federal Funds Obligated by this Action by the Pass-Through Entity to the SUBRECIPIENT	\$775,000
Total Amount of Federal Funds Obligated to the SUBRECIPIENT by the Pass-Through Entity (Including the Current Obligation)	\$775,000
Total Amount of the Federal Award Committed to the SUBRECIPIENT by the Pass-Through Entity	\$775,000

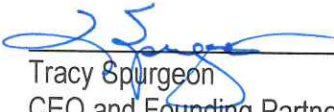
